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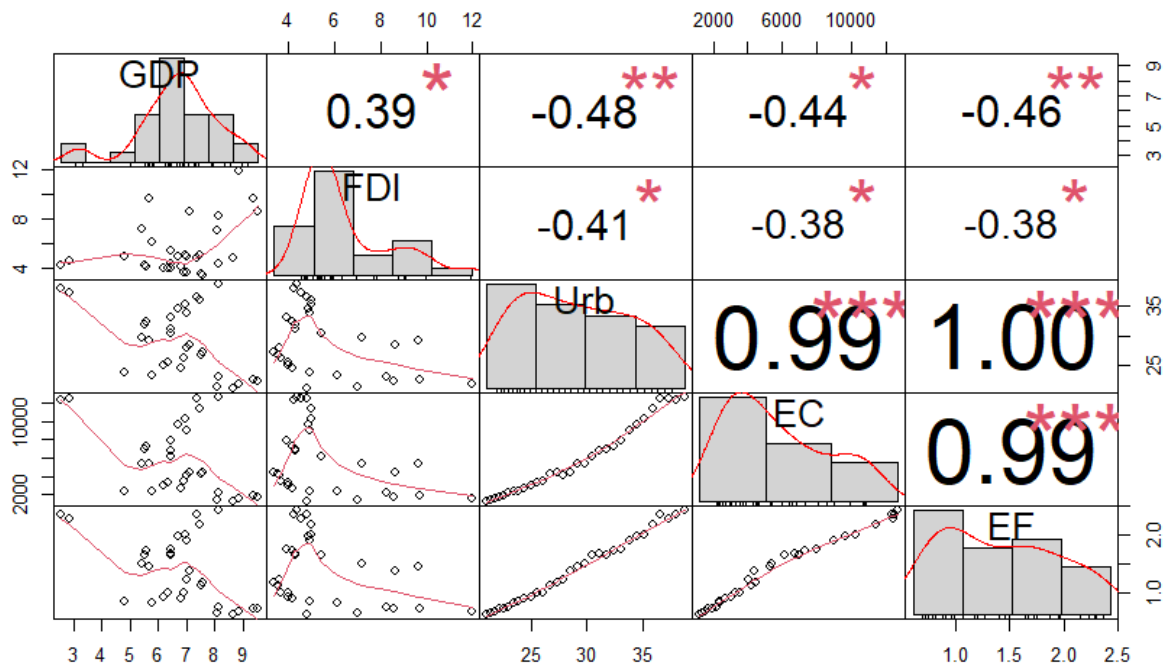
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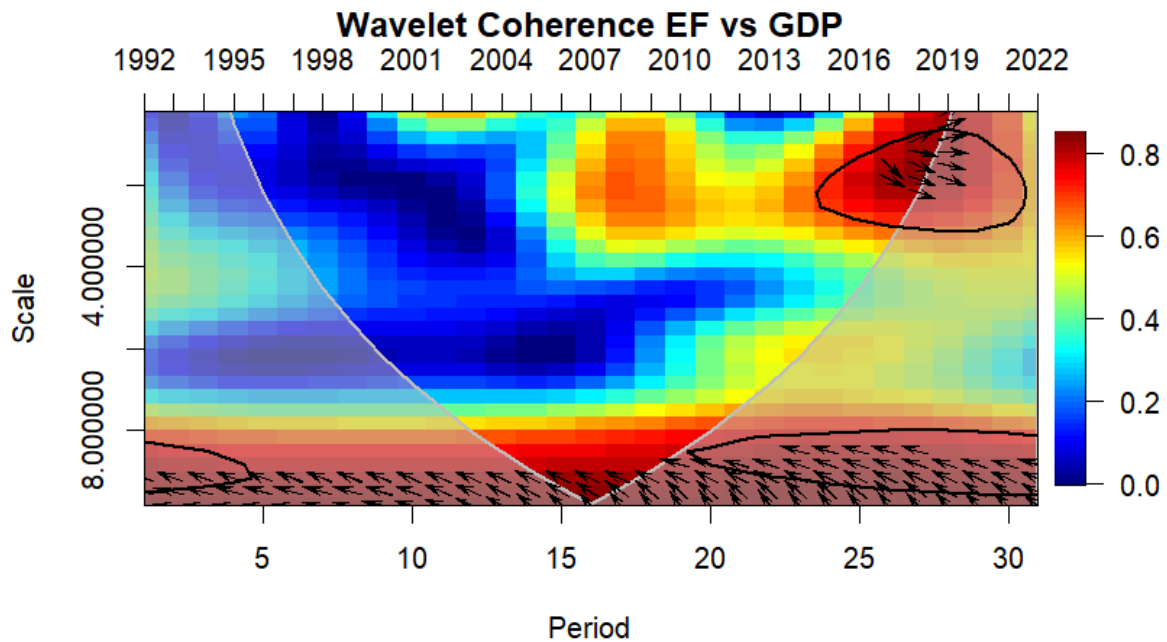

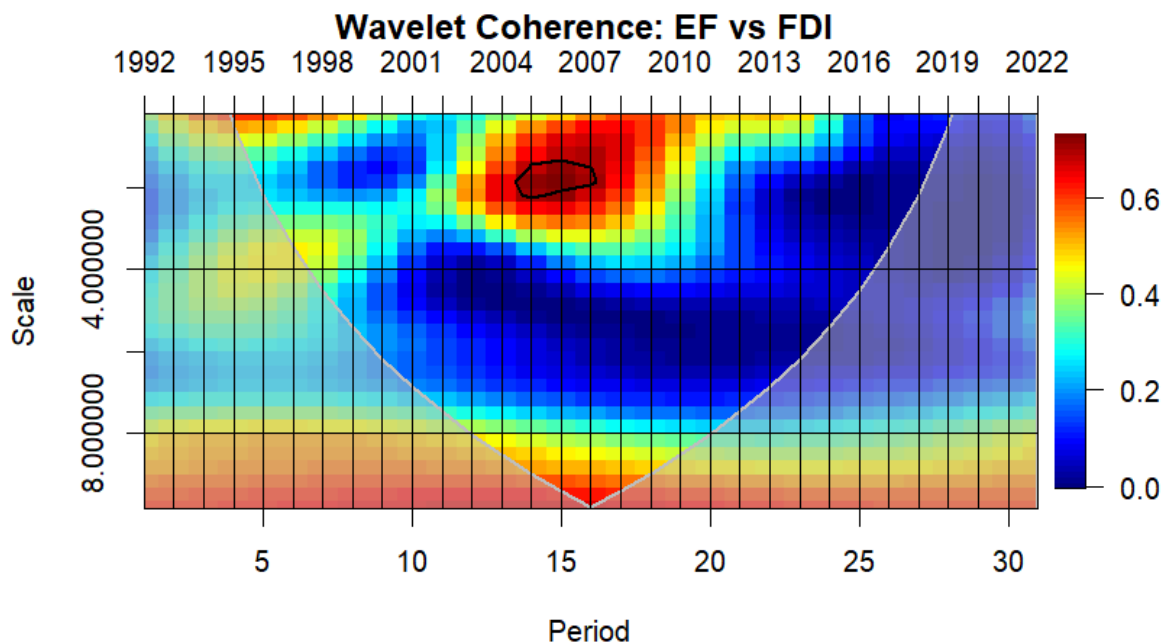
Appendix 2. Correlation Matrix between GDP, FDI, EC, Urb, and EF



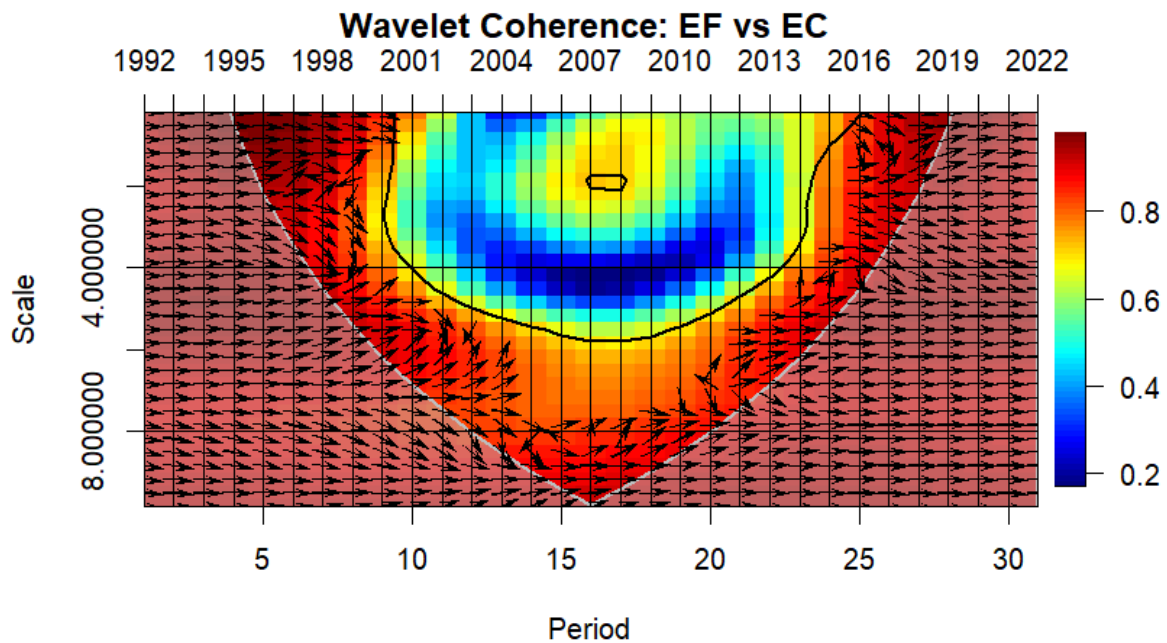
Appendix 3. Cross-wavelet transform between EF and GDP
